What is RIPE?

- Non-incorporated group of Internet folks
- RIPE meetings 2 times a year
- *Not* the RIPE NCC
 - RIPE NCC is the regional Internet registry
 - They also organize RIPE meetings
 - RIPE *does* set RIPE NCC policy
- Has a number of "working groups"
 - Cover specific topics, like DNS or routing
 - Discussions on e-mail lists, at RIPE meetings

RIPE IPv6 Working Group

- Someone thought IPv6 might take off...
 someday
 - And it might! ;)
 - Started in RIPE 26 (1997)
 - Watched IPv6 developments, brought to RIPE
- Recharter a few years ago
 - Try to shift focus from "observing" to "pushing"
 - Added 2 co-chairs, Marco Hogewoning & me
